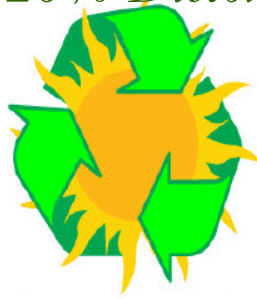

Each year, the UK generates around 100 million tonnes of waste from households, commerce and industry. Landfill tax is to rise by £8 to £48 a ton next year and will climb further, as the Government seeks to meet European Union landfill diversion targets. Recycling & Wastes Management is an industry where cross-sector working and partnerships are essential in order for the many innovative projects to realise their potential. The Plant and Waste Recycling Awards aim to promote industry innovation and excellence.
